**The Clean Technologies & Sustainable Industries ECHS was developed by the Ballston Spa Central School District in partnership with Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC) and the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) in 2011. It now has over 50 partners from business and industry, higher education, and non-profit and government agencies. The Clean Technologies & Sustainable Industries ECHS was awarded a NYS P-TECH grant which expanded opportunities for students in the program to take college coursework in one of several career pathways.

High school students in the program have the opportunity to complete an Associate's Degree at no cost to families in one of the program's college and career pathways; Clean Energy, Community Health Navigation, Cybersecurity, Engineering Sciences, Entrepreneurship, Polysomnography, and Surgical Technician.

Students in the program create solutions to real world problems during their experiences in the program through a transdisciplinary approach. They also enroll in college coursework with college professors at Hudson Valley Community College's TEC-SMART in Malta.
